Some Notation Tips

Bar lines separate the music into measures

This is one measure, the section of the staff in between two bar lines.

A Double Bar line is added at the end of a song.

Notes on or *above* the middle line of the staff go down.
Notes on or *below* the middle line go up.

These stems go up

These stems go down.
